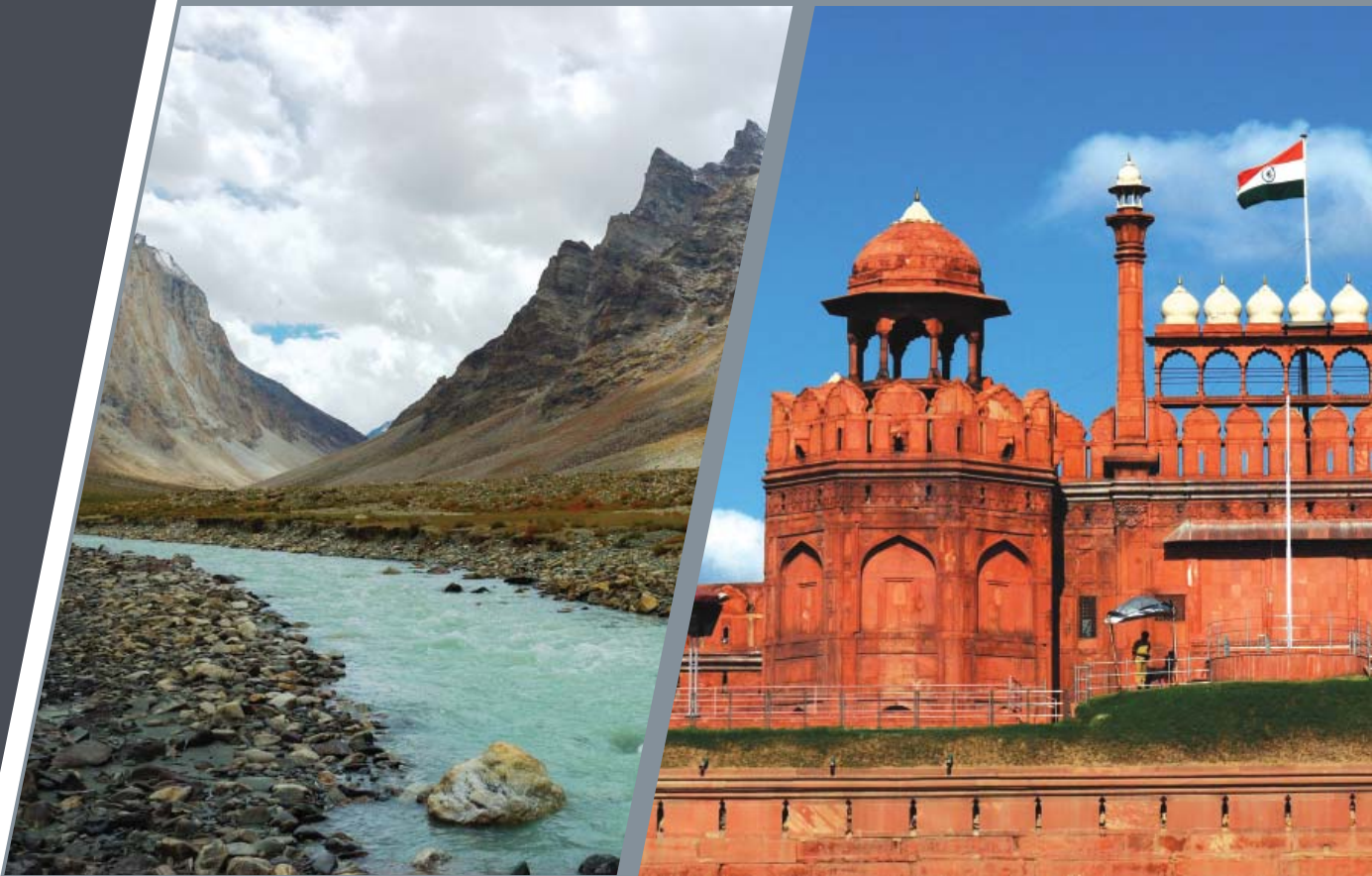

GEO India 2011 – Shaping India's Petroleum Future

The Indian Government is striving to reduce the country's dependency on imported hydrocarbons. Currently these account for 70% of its energy needs.

In recent years, the auctioning of exploration blocks under the New Exploration Licensing Programme (NELP) has opened up the Indian petroleum sector. In addition a more liberal oil regulatory regime has been adopted. This has encouraged much greater involvement of private sector operators and critically, foreign investors. The results have been dramatic with a huge increase in the numbers of E&P projects.

At present two thirds of India's sedimentary basins remain unexplored. In order to achieve the government's goal and release the country's full hydrocarbon potential, it must confront a wide range of technical and business challenges. All these factors combine to present the petroleum industry with an equally extensive set of opportunities.

The Conference

GEO India 2011 conference theme is: 'Exploring and Producing beyond Frontiers'. The conference programme is being coordinated by two leading geoscience societies: American Association of Petroleum Geologists (AAPG) and Association of Petroleum Geologists, India (APG). This combination of local and international expertise will ensure that the programme will be highly technical with leading edge science brought from around the world mixed with local knowledge from the region's leading geoscientists. In addition to the technical programme there will be extensive poster presentations, workshops and field trips. In this exciting conference mix senior industry figures will address topics that are relevant to the current energy climate in India. These will include regulatory policy, advances in technology, reservoir characterization, new play concepts, environmental concerns and frontier exploration areas in the Indian Subcontinent.

The Exhibition

The exhibition is the largest showcase of geoscience products and services in India, attracting NOCs, IOCs and major operating companies. Previous high profile exhibitors include the Oil & Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC) and the government's Directorate General of Hydrocarbons; Fugro, Cairn, Schlumberger, Halliburton, Wavefield and CGG Veritas; and numerous new entries to the Indian market.
